

DBS Privacy Policy - Applicant Declaration

On May 25th 2018 the **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** (EU) 2016/679 comes into force. It is a regulation in EU law on data protection and privacy for all individuals within the European Union and replaces the 1995 Data Protection Directive. The GDPR aims primarily to give control to citizens and residents over their personal data and to simplify the regulatory environment for international business by unifying the regulation within the EU. It also addresses the export of personal data outside the EU.

To comply with the GDPR legislation the Disclosure and Barring Service has produced a number of privacy policies for applicants that should be read and understood before submitting a DBS application.

In addition to the existing applicant declaration on the DBS application it is now a requirement that the declaration below is completed in order for the application to be processed.
